8. Download charts to use maps and features without cell service.



West - Minimal distance to include shoreline.



Markers show different points of interest and are accessed from the menu.




After import, all marker icons are default as:

1. Tap “Menu” and select “Markers” to display active markers.





2. After selecting a marker of your choosing, it will display the location on the chart. Use the steps below to change the icon:

- HINT: Changing icons in the marker database one by one is the best way to learn what the area has to offer.



NAVIONICS MARKERS - ICON KEY



- “(Landmark)” - Well known location for area reference.



- “(R)” - Waterfront Restaurants + type of dockage.



- “(Fish)” - Recommended fishing areas.



- “(Anchorage)” - Recommended spots to anchor.



- “(Hazard)” - Large shallow areas.

NAVIONICS ROUTES - DATABASE


1. Tap "Menu" and select "Routes" to display premade routes.





2. After choosing your route from the database, numbered way points and pink line will guide you on a preset path to your destination.



3. Return trip home, follow the steps below.



NAVIONICS ROUTES - TIPS

1. After selecting your route and clicking the green start button, the app will begin collecting data for a new “Track” entry.




“Tracks” collect speed and mileage data over the course of your time on the water.

This data and a bread crumb trail can be saved under “Tracks” on the main menu.



When finished navigating, tap the “Stop” button.

2. After selecting “Stop” the following options appear and refer only to “Tracks.” Pressing “Delete” does not delete the route, just the “Track” entry.



“Track” entries take up a lot of storage. We don’t recommend saving “Tracks” unless you would like to reference that outing in the future.

3. After ending the “Tracks” click on “Route” to stop all navigation.
